Prison and Jail Ministry (by Cheryl Kuhn)

Looking for a place to be used by the Lord? Come minister at the jail house or prison ministry. This is an opportunity to do one-on-one ministry. There is nothing like looking into an inmate's eyes and watching the truth of the Lord's words bring understanding and restoration. This ministry is a way for you to bring a life change for an individual.

We minister at the Harris County Jail, and at various Texas Prisons. The Holy Spirit moves in compassion. We have seen 6 or 7 ladies receive

their spiritual language all within a few minutes. We have seen them break and cry and accept Jesus as Lord and Savior. We have seen them restored to health both physically and emotionally. One young woman began to shake under the power of the Lord- she received her spiritual language and received a relationship with a God full of his love. Talk about life changing!

This is a time when people are at a low point in their lives and nothing but a change

will keep them from returning to prison should they be released. This opportunity to minister to prisoners is open to both men and women. There is also an opportunity to minister to the families of the inmates.

Our heart is that everyone we come in contact with will have an experience with God and that He will become real to them. This is a time where we are declaring the truth of the Lord over someone's life. We are allowing them to meet

the living Father through the workings of his Holy Spirit.

To Be Known Just Draw Near

Some of my favorite stories in the gospels are of Jesus reaching out to those with hungry, seeking hearts- because I was one of those individuals. These people were looking for something but had not found it until they met Jesus. Zaccheus was willing to climb a tree (probably in the midst of a crowd that did not like him very much) just to catch a glimpse of Jesus. As the story continues Zaccheus spends an evening with Jesus and is transformed because of the encounter.

In John 4, a Samaritan woman who had had many husbands comes to a well when most other women would not be there, only to have a life changing encounter with Jesus as He uncovers the depths of her heart and reveals to her that He is the Messiah. She is so transformed she runs back to town to encourage others to come meet Jesus so they too could have a life changing encounter with Him. Jesus stayed for a few days and many ended up believing in Him because of the testimony of this woman.

The desire to be known and really loved is at the core of the human heart, and God is the only One Who can do that perfectly. He set it up that way. He made us with this desire, while knowing that He alone can completely accomplish this. The same is at the core of His heart. He, too, longs to be known and loved as He really is. In an astounding passage, Jesus makes this point clear. In Matthew 7:21-23, Jesus tells the story of His not being allowed to know (have intimate relationship with) individuals even though they apparently called Him "Lord" and did kingdom works. Jesus' reply was "...I never knew you; depart from Me" to paraphrase: "You never allowed Me to know you, depart from Me."

Jesus told Mary that she had "chosen the good part, which shall not be taken away from her" (Luke 10:42) He didn't rebuke Martha for her service but there was something that He longed for more than service. He wanted to be chosen. He wanted her to spend time listening and receiving from Him. As long as we look to anything other than Jesus to fill us, we will never be totally satisfied. We are the ones doing the choosing. As we draw near to God, He will draw near to us (James 4:8) giving us what we long for while we are giving Him what He longs for.
